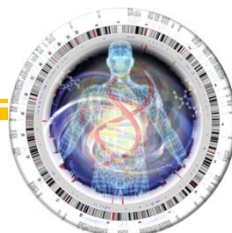
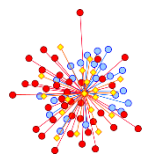

David Tiemeier received his BS in Chemistry from the University of Notre Dame and PhD in Biochemistry from the University of California, Berkeley. Following postdoctoral studies in molecular genetics at the National Institutes of Health, he took his first position in the Medical School at UC Irvine. He was recruited to Monsanto/Searle to start its group in molecular genetics and eventually became Searle's Vice President, Global Business Development. He worked in Pfizer and the startup world before returning to university life. His presentation will focus on approaches he pursued at the University of Chicago and Northwestern University to translate academic research into social and commercial opportunities. Over the last two years, he led the Research Translation Group at UCI as Managing Director and has now moved into a Senior Advisor role.
